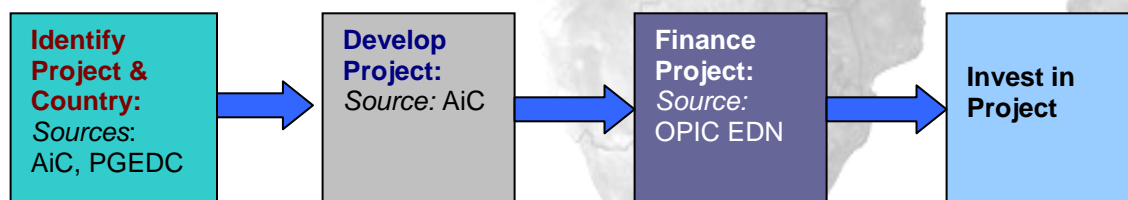
Have you ever asked yourself these questions?
